DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Application

Open the cap end of the marker. Fix funnel to the one litre ink container. Fill the pen tube, leaving a 20mm gap at the top. Firmly replace the cap. Hold the pen in downward position and press the retractable nib only once to establish ink flow to the tip. This may have to be repeated on a dry or new nib.
